



2020/2021 Ski & Ride Season at Stowe Mountain Resort

For everyone's safety operations at Stowe Mountain Resort will be a little different this year. Here are some tips to help you prepare and give you an idea of what to expect to make sure you get the most out of your ski & ride vacation!

Before you arrive:

- For your convenience, lift tickets will only be sold online before you arrive. Please plan ahead to make sure you're able to secure tickets for your party before you arrive in Vermont!
- Reservations are now required for your day on the mountain for both Epic Pass holders and Epic Day Passes. This is to help ensure social and physical distancing. [Click here](#) for more detailed information.
- Reservations are easy to submit, as real-time availability is available on epicpass.com
- [Day lift tickets](#) will go on sale December 8th for the season.

At the mountain:

- Face coverings are required to access any resort building or services. This includes, but is not limited to: lift lines, riding chairlifts and inside gondolas, base lodges, during all ski and snowboard lessons, and inside restaurant except when actively eating at a table.
- [Ski & Ride lessons](#) are available this year. They do need to be booked in advance and will run at limited capacities. Participants are required to complete a pre-arrival health screening.
- All transactions at the mountain will be cashless this year. This includes: restaurants, Ski & Ride School, on-mountain shops, and all other point of sale.

Mountain Road Transportation:

- The mountain road shuttle will be operating this year.
- Face coverings are required to enter the bus.
- Passengers will enter the bus from the rear door and buses will run at a limited capacity to promote distancing.
- Please use the hand sanitizing stations that are located at the bus entrances.
